When the setting sun illuminates the houses of the Quai de la Poissonnerie and a family of swans accompanies you back to the pier, then the Little Venice of Colmar has offered you some of its enchantment.

When the gentle green of the cloister of the Unterlinden Museum leads you to its chapel to confront the abundance and modernity of the Issenheim Altarpiece, more than 500 years of Rhenish history are revealed to you.

When, at dusk, the Alsatian song of the night watchman surprises you and resounds in the alleys of Turckheim, then this proud wine village has shared with you a part of its centuries-old history.

When, after cycling through the vineyards of our Grands Crus, you are charmed by a pleasant courtyard full of flowers and a winegrower introduces you to his liquid gold, then the soul of the Alsace Wine Route has revealed itself to you.

Colmar, an exceptional architectural heritage

The vast pedestrian zone of old Colmar, classified as a "safeguarded sector", displays a rich heritage, both civil and religious, perfectly preserved, from the Middle Ages to the 18th century, making it a real open-air museum.

- 1 • The "Little Venice" district with its fascinating colourful facades.
- 2 • The Tanneurs district and its large houses with white facades.
- 3 • The majestic Saint Martin Collegiate Church, whose yellow Rouffach sandstone reflects the sun's rays in a shimmering fashion.

- 4 • The Pfister House, Renaissance period, with a beautiful corner oriel and rich wall paintings.
- 5 • The majestic House of Heads with its 106 face sculptures.
- 6 • The Koifhus, an emblematic place in the history of wine, whose roof offers a bewitching visual spectacle.

The German Quarter

Welcome to the Southern Quarter!

The private houses and administrative buildings impose the architectural trend of 'modernism' on Colmar and reveal German influences.

The facades of the buildings are decorated with neo-Romanesque, neo-Gothic, neo-Renaissance and Art Deco architecture. The elegance of the southern district, crossed by the Lauch, calls for a certain gentle way of life and makes it one of the most popular districts in contemporary Colmar. Discover the symbols of this district such as the Villa aux raisins, the Château Kiener or the Villa Boeschlin.

Alsatian culture

An ever-present identity and heritage!

The flag

Alsace wears its colours high thanks to the "Rot un Wiss"! This regional flag unites the two emblems of the Haut-Rhin and the Bas-Rhin, and unites the Alsatians under a single banner. The colours of the Counts of Werd, **red and white**, are added to **6 yellow crowns** symbolising the aspirations of the Habsburg dynasty from Alsace.



The Alsatian language

The result of a tumultuous historical heritage, Alsatian is still spoken today. Perceptible to German speakers, this unique dialect brings the warmth and authenticity characteristic of Alsace. Dear to the Alsatians, it is spoken at school, with family and friends over Stämmtisch!*

The costumes

Dressed for festivals, ceremonies and folk dances, these genuine "haute-couture" pieces were once used to represent the **different regions of Alsace**. However, in popular culture, a traditional version from Strasbourg is still the most widespread.

The men's suit consists of a white shirt tied at the neck with a black braid, a red double-breasted waistcoat and a set of black trousers and jacket, all decorated with gold buttons representing the man's wealth.

The female costume is more elaborate. It consists of a white blouse often decorated with lace, a black embroidered apron and worn over a skirt mainly in red or blue, indicating the woman's religion. Many accessories are added, such as a bib, corselet, stockings or shawl.

The traditional Alsatian headdress, consisting of a black cap with a long strip of black fabric sewn onto it, forming a knot above the head and falling down the back, is a further highlight of the outfit.

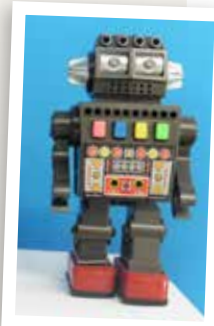

SUMMER

Summer is a time for tasty aperitifs with friends... Here are our favourites for sharing a 100% Alsatian aperitif: **the pretzel, the tarte flambée "Flammakuacha"** (plain, au gratin or with Munster cheese) or the **kougelhopf** to be enjoyed in a salted or sweet version: great classics!

FALL

The autumn colours that cover the vineyards are reminiscent of the colours of the Alsace grape varieties. A good glass of **white wine**, accompanied by the inevitable **sauerkraut (Choucroute in french)**, will fully immerse you in the conviviality of the region.



SPRING

At the beginning of the year, during the carnival season, everyone enjoys the taste of **schankalas**. These little doughnuts containing almond powder delight everyone's taste buds. The arrival of spring is marked by the Easter celebrations, an important time in Alsace where Good Friday is a bank holiday. For the occasion, families and bakers prepare the traditional **lamalas**: a soft sponge cake, sprinkled with icing sugar and representing the Easter lamb. .

Come and discover, in the secrecy of some of Colmar's alleyways, a rare fact: two ancestral families of winegrowers still raise their liquid gold here..



Land of Grands Crus !

Wettolsheim, the leading wine-producing commune in the Haut-Rhin, has two Grands Crus: **Steingrubler** and **Pfersigberg**. These two Grands Crus produce excellent "late harvest" and "Sélection Grains Nobles" wines.

Emblematic of the Alsace Wine Route, **Turckheim** is a land whose history is intimately linked to the wine. Its Grand Cru **Brand** benefits from an exceptional amount of sunshine.

Nestled on a hillside, the lovely village of **Niedermorschwihr** is the birthplace of the Grand Cru **Sommerberg**. Facing due south, it is the perfect place to grow Riesling, one of the most important grape variety from Alsace.

In **Ingersheim**, the Grand Cru **Florimont** is characterised by its size and generosity. Situated on south-facing slopes and protected by the



Vosges mountains, this Grand Cru is blessed with privileged climatic conditions. Not forgetting the famous **Hengst** from **Wintzenheim**.

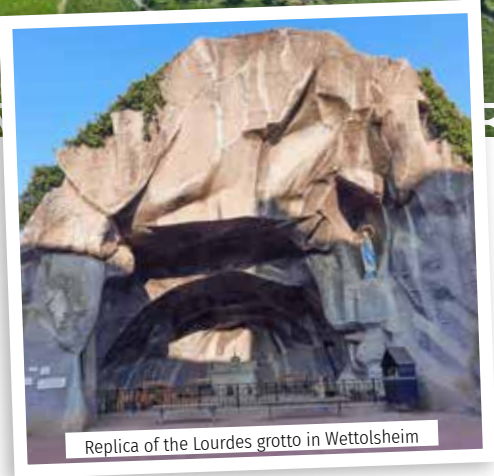

The legend of the dragon of Turckheim

"A long time ago, when the Rhine Valley formed a large lake, a stray dragon emerged from the waters to settle on the shore at Letzenberg, near the present-day village of Turckheim. Tired and soothed by the gentle tranquillity of



the place, he dozed off. The sun took advantage of his rest to shine more and more brightly to melt his scales. A battle of fire broke out between the dragon and the shining star. The dragon was angry and spat flames at the burning sun, and eventually its blood was spilled all around the place called Drachenloch, or dragon's hole. Centuries later, once the waters had receded, people planted vines on this beautiful hill. The land, fertilized by the dragon's blood, gave birth to one of the Alsace Grands Crus: the BRAND."

The fighting in the sector of Colmar

By the end of 1944, the liberation of France progressed rapidly. A zone of German resistance formed around Colmar and the fighting continued until February 1945, in extremely difficult conditions due to the particularly harsh winter that year and the terrain which offered virtually no natural cover.

Memorial of the Croix du Moulin

In the town of Jepsheim, which was heavily affected by the fighting around Colmar, there is a building that recalls the fierce fighting. This place of remembrance evokes the dedication of the soldiers and keeps intact the memory of this dramatic episode. On the circular base in pink Vosges sandstone is engraved in three languages, French, German and English: **"THEY ARE UNITED IN DEATH, LET US UNITE IN PEACE".**



Audie Murphy Memorial

Located in the village of Holtzwihr, a **memorial** is dedicated to Lieutenant **Audie MURPHY** and the soldiers of the 3rd American Infantry Division. The memorial pays tribute to this famous Hollywood actor of the 1950s who became a war hero in Alsace by single-handedly repelling a German counter-attack after having sent his men to take cover. Decorated with the American medal of honour, this soldier ended the war as the most decorated of his army during the Second World War. He still achieves today the beautiful performance of gathering his compatriots more than 8000 kilometres from home, in a charming Alsatian village!

An essential part of your visit to Alsace

This fairy tale castle looks down majestically across the Alsace plain for 900 years. Towering at 757 m over picture perfect villages and colourful vineyards, it is one of France's most widely visited castles. Restored in the early 20th century, its current state reflects how it looked in the 15th century. Passing the main gate of the impressive Haut-Koenigsbourg is to enter the medieval world. An enjoyable and breathtaking experience!

The Pflixbourg castle

Built in 1219 by Albin Wolflin at an altitude of 454 m, the Pflixbourg castle and its tower rise above the Wintzenheim forest to protect the Fecht valley. In the dungeon of the Pflixbourg, a legend survives. It tells that a beautiful princess was once transformed by a fairy into a monster, half woman, half dragon. Only a knight's kiss could restore her form. Will you rescue her?

Storming the castles!

In the heart of the Hohlandsbourg massif stand the remains of three medieval castles of an astonishing architectural and landscape diversity..

The Hohlandsbourg castle

Once the capital of the Habsburg seigniory, from the top of these 620 metres, come and discover the most beautiful view of Colmar and its surroundings. The fortress of the Hohlandsbourg castle is today the scene of a medieval history combining exhibitions and thematic shows. A programme of activities rich in discoveries and adventures!

The Hagueneck castle

This charming castle nestles discreetly at the bottom of the forest valley of Wettolsheim, not far from the Route des Cinq Châteaux. Built around 1230 and then destroyed during the Thirty Years' War, the keep has been partly restored thanks to the support of a local non-profit organization. Wake up the knight in you by climbing up its tower!

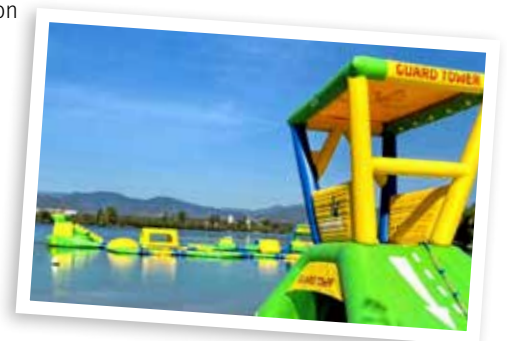

The Trois-Epis and its Galtz

The real Alsatian Corcovado

At Trois-Épis, in 1491, the Virgin Mary appeared to a blacksmith on his way to Niedermorschwihr. For more than 500 years, diocesan priests and religious communities have perpetuated the most famous Marian cult in Alsace. The Galtz is a rocky spur near the Trois-Epis on which a monumental statue of Christ blessing the Alsace plain was erected in 1930 in recognition of the return of Alsace to France. The hike is accessible and the view incredible!

Discovering Street Art

When walls talk...

In Colmar, there is no shortage of opportunities to discover urban art. From the Grillenbreit car park to the Canal port, via the Rue Billing, these places of expression, witness to improvised jam sessions, offer the curious the works of local and international artists.

Turckheim places art between vineyards and mountains

Initiated by the Arkédia Olry company, it is in the Chemin du Heilgass in Turckheim that the Arké-di'art festival brings together artists from here and elsewhere every year. Their talents are expressed over more than a hundred metres, in a unique setting.



Street art treasure hunt!

Colmar, source of inspiration in Japan

Studio Ghibli was inspired by the traditional houses of Colmar to create the setting for the film "Howl's Moving Castle" by director Hayao Miyazaki.

Hayao Miyazaki, director of animated films and co-founder of Studio Ghibli, drew inspiration for one of his films from the atmosphere of Alsatian villages, notably Colmar and Riquewihr. His film, "The Travelling Castle", released in 2005, captures the charm of Alsatian architecture.



Gochuumon wa Usagi Desu Ka?

The Pfister House and the Koïffhus, two emblematic monuments of Colmar, or the typical half-timbered houses figure prominently in the work of this master of Japanese animation.

There is also the anime "Gochuumon wa Usagi Desu Ka?" by the mangaka Koi, which takes place in a town that is clearly reminiscent of Colmar.

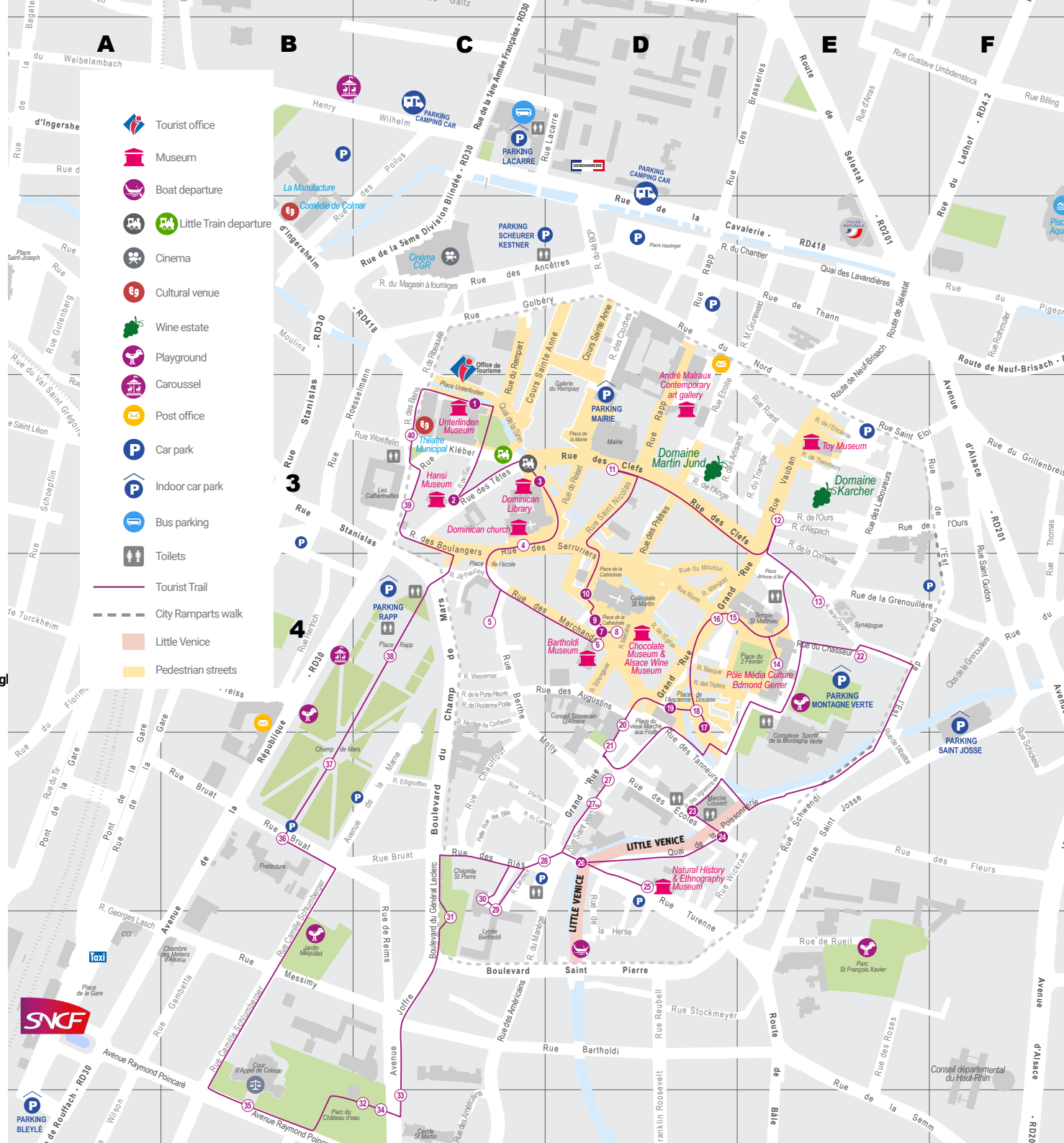
